Vineyards: Bakers Gully, Kangarilla

Aroma:

This wine displays an abundance of ripe black fruit such as blackberry and Satsuma plum and is further complexed by hints of dusty dark chocolate, clove, fennel and liquorice.

Palate:

The palate is voluptuous, mouth filling and rich, with a velvety smooth texture that is packed with a plum pudding like flavour. It is a traditional McLaren Vale old clone vine Shiraz, finishing with dusty tannins and hints of pepper.

Cellaring: This single vineyard Shiraz would benefit from 2 years cellaring.
